TOPIC: Fall Fishery on the Wenatchee River

ACTION REQUESTED: Authorize weekly fall fishing periods on the Wenatchee River.

FORMAL ACTION TAKEN: Coho are returning to the Wenatchee River in good numbers, primarily due to efforts of the YN Mid-Columbia Coho Program. A surplus above production needs exists and tribal fishers should be allowed to share in the harvest. Therefore, the Fish and Wildlife Committee hereby authorizes a fishery on the Wenatchee River weekly from 6 a.m. Tuesdays to 6 p.m. Saturdays, through November 29, 2014. Standard subsistence gears will be allowed (platform/h&l) and snagging of fish is specifically prohibited. Fishing in the Wenatchee River is allowed within one mile of Dryden Dam, except fishing is not allowed within 25-feet of the entrance of any fishway. This fishery will be monitored for impacts to Bull Trout and may close if necessary to protect Bull Trout. This regulation is pursuant to Chapter 32.14 of the Revised Law and Order Code of the Yakama Nation.

A surplus above production needs exists and tribal fishers should be allowed to share in the harvest. Therefore, the Fish and Wildlife Committee hereby authorizes a fishery on the Icicle River weekly from 6 a.m. Tuesdays to 6 p.m. Saturdays, through November 29, 2014. Standard subsistence gears will be allowed (platform/h&l) and snagging of fish is specifically prohibited. Fishing in the Icicle River is allowed where it borders the Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery. This fishery will be monitored for impacts to Bull Trout and may close if necessary to protect Bull Trout. This regulation is pursuant to Chapter 32.14 of the Revised Law and Order Code of the Yakama Nation.

FORMAL ACTION TAKEN: Coho are returning to the Methow River in good numbers, primarily due to efforts of the YN Mid-Columbia Coho Program. A surplus above production needs exists and tribal fishers should be allowed to share in the harvest. Therefore, the Fish and Wildlife Committee hereby authorizes a fishery on the Methow River weekly from 6 a.m. Tuesdays to 6 p.m. Saturdays, through November 29, 2014. Standard subsistence gears will be allowed (platform/h&l) and snagging of fish is specifically prohibited. Fishing in the Methow River is allowed in the Spring Creek Channel behind Wintrop National Fish Hatchery, except fishing is not allowed within 25-feet of the entrance of any fishway. This fishery will be monitored for impacts to Bull Trout and may close if necessary to protect Bull Trout. This regulation is pursuant to Chapter 32.14 of the Revised Law and Order Code of the Yakama Nation.
