TOPIC: 2019 Spring Fishery

ACTION REQUESTED: **Re-Open** Platform/H&L Subsistence Fishery.

FORMAL ACTION TAKEN: The spring chinook runsize has been updated and now estimated that 70,500 spring chinook will return to the mouth of the Columbia River. With an increase in runsize, there is also an increase in available harvestable spring chinook for the Zone 6 Platform/ H&L fishery. Therefore, the Fish and Wildlife committee hereby re-opens the platform h&l fishery for subsistence only at 6am Wednesday June 12, 2019 until Dec 31, 2019. Authority to enforce these regulations is provided under Section 32.18.05 of the Code. Violations of any of these regulations are punishable under Section 32.18.05 of the Code. All other regulations in T-76-19 will remain unchanged.
