RE: CA- 608-2026-2 Open Weekly Fall Coho Fishing
periods on Icicle River

The Yakama Nation Fish & Wildlife Committee authorize weekly fishery openings on the Icicle River from 6 a.m. Mondays to 9 p.m. Saturdays effective September 28 through November 21, 2026. The following regulations are issued pursuant to Title 32.14 of the Revised Law & Order Code of the Yakama Nation. Authority to enforce these regulations is provided under Section 32.18.07 of the Code. Violations of any of these regulations are punishable under Section 32.18.07 of the Code.

FISHING AREA: Icicle River- Mouth upstream, including the historic channel, to 500 feet above the Icicle Irrigation District Diversion Dam.

SANCTUARIES: Fishing within 25-feet of Fish Ladder Entrances is prohibited

DATES: Weekly from 6am Mondays to 9pm Saturdays
September 28 – November 21, 2026

GEAR: Standard subsistence (platform/H&L) gears authorized. Single or double hooks only. NO treble hooks, NO snagging of fish.

OTHER: Camping and Parking are allowed in designated areas only. Due to High Fire Danger Campfires are subject to local regulations. Trash is Pack it in In/Pack it Out, or put in available trash receptacles.

The Fishery will be monitored for impacts to other species and brood collections targets and may close to protect these interests.
