

- Highest Priority
- Mainly filled in Spring
- Commercial Sale Not Allowed at same time
- Tribes have not reached consensus in many years
- Some Tribes authorize H&L for Permits below Bonneville Dam
- Other Tribes Limited Elders H&L Below Bonneville Dam
- Below Bonneville Dam H&L counted as Permits

Platform/Hook & Line



- Second Highest Priority
- Considered Base Subsistence Fishery
- 10,000 C&S Fish Entitlement
- Staff recommends 4.0% HR for Spring Zone 6
- Management Goal: Open Year Around with Sunday Closures
- Commercial Sale opened 6/4/22 due to increased return
- Commercial Sale has continued through October or December

- Platform/H&L Open Throughout (Sunday Closures)

- June 16 to July 31 for Chinook
- Forecasts
 - Chinook = 84,800
 - Sockeye = 234,500
 - A-Index Steelhead = 55,400
 - Wild A-Index = 17,300
 - B-Index Steelhead = 8,000
 - Wild B-Index = 1,300
- Good Chinook Forecast
- Good Sockeye Forecast
- No summer harvest rate limit on steelhead



- Treaty Catch Guidelines Depend on Actual not forecast run
 - Chinook ~ 23,550 (50% Sharing Formula) (allowed catch will depend on planned ocean harvest – counted in non-treaty share)
 - Sockeye = 16,415 (7%)
- **■** Expect Commercial Gillnet Season
 - Begin June 19??? June 16 is a Friday
- Mesh Restriction For Sockeye
- Platform/h&l
 - Don't catch much Chinook (Maybe 1,000)
 - Can catch Sockeye (up to ~ 5%)

 - June 16 July 28
- Summer Chinook Catch 14,960 (19% HR)
- Sockeye Catch 27,344 (4.1% HR)
- 7 in mesh restriction first 4 openings
