TOPIC:

Modification of subsistence fishing regulations for the Wind River.

ACTION REQUESTED: Open weekly Spring Chinook fishing on the Wind River.

FORMAL ACTION TAKEN: Section II D 2.a of T-64-21 states subsistence fishing opportunity on the Wind River will be assessed throughout the season. Inseason information shows returns to Carson National Fish Hatchery have been very good with broodstock collection near complete. Therefore, the Fish and Wildlife Committee hereby authorizes the modification of the Wind River subsistence fishing regulations to allow weekly openings on the Wind River from Noon Mondays to 6 p.m. Saturdays, both above and below Shipperd Falls, through June 26, 2021. All other regulations in section II.D of T-64-21 remain unchanged. Regulations are pursuant to Title 32.14 of the Revised Law & Order Code of the Yakama Nation. Authority to enforce these regulations is provided under Section 32.18.07 of the Code. Violations of any of these regulations are punishable under Section 32.18.07 of the Code.
