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Notice of Pre-Bid Site Visit: Upper Nason Habitat Project

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Dear Contractor:

The Yakama Nation's Upper Columbia Habitat Restoration Project is planning to provide a pre-bid project tour for an upcoming instream habitat restoration project taking place on Nason Creek in Chelan County, Washington, in the summer of 2023.

The Yakama Nation intends to accept construction company bids for this project area in the winter or early spring of 2023, however we are still completing the final construction bid packet for this project area and won't be asking for bids at this time.

Given the project site's high elevation in the Wenatchee Subbasin, we are seeking to provide the only pre-bid project tour to potential construction contractors on **Tuesday**, **October 25th**, **2022**, so that the site can be reviewed by interested parties before winter conditions set in. The site tour will be led by Yakama Nation Fisheries Habitat Biologist Chris Butler, who is the Project Manager, and Dan Miller, the Engineer of Record from Interfluve Inc.

Pre-registration for this site visit with Chris Butler is required. To register your attendance please email Chris Butler at butlerc@yakamafish-nsn.gov stating your company name, and the names of all members of your party that plan on attending the tour.

Please note that tour is expected to take several hours and will require walking several miles, so please be prepared with adequate food, water, and clothing for touring a rugged natural area with standing water. Hip boots are not recommended as some wet crossings are hip high. Chest waders are recommended for the many wet crossings along this tour.
